

# All About Altars

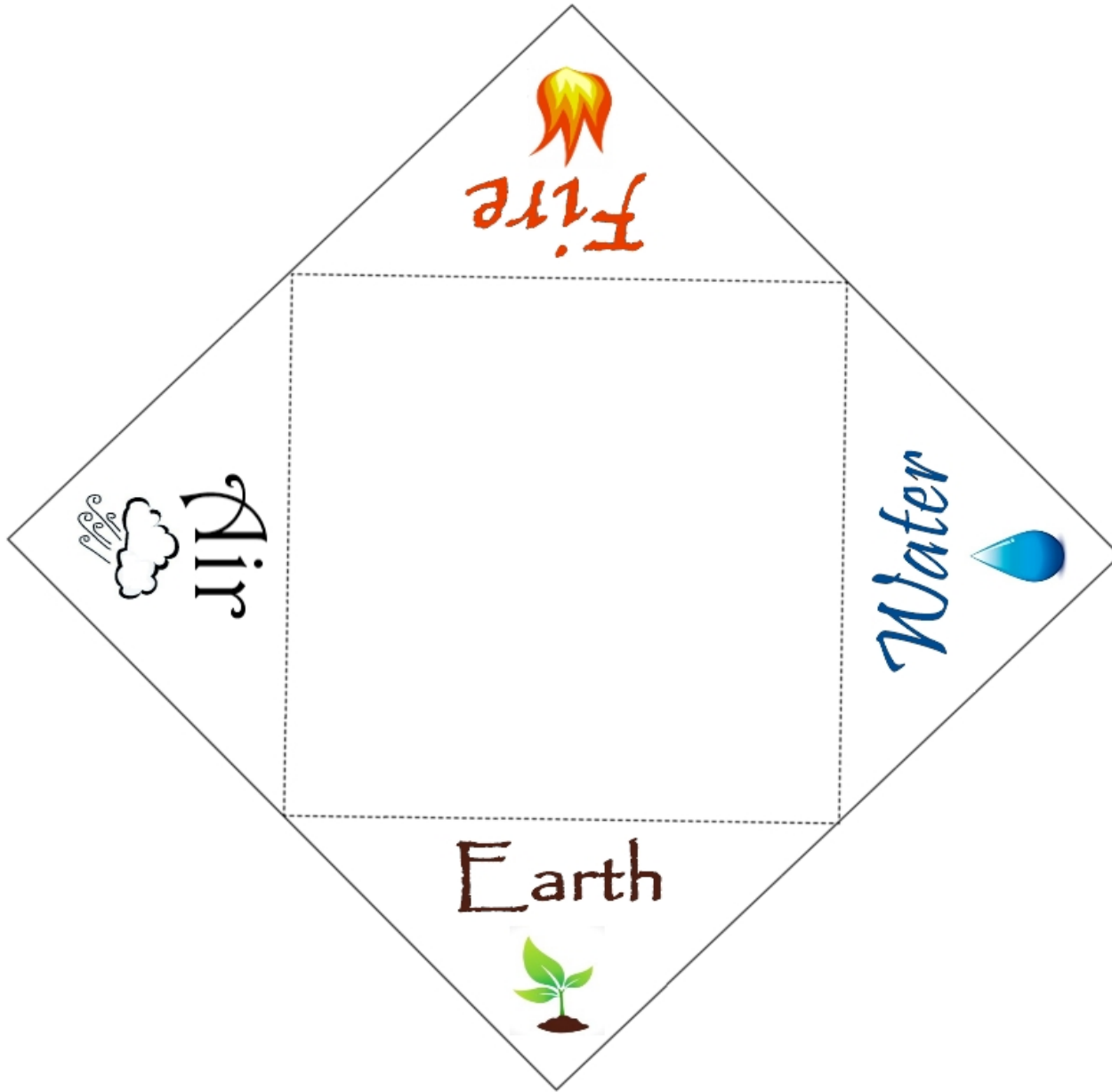
These pages contain all the pieces you need to make a lapbook on altars. Basically, all the components can be cut out along their borders, with the dotted lines indicated folds.

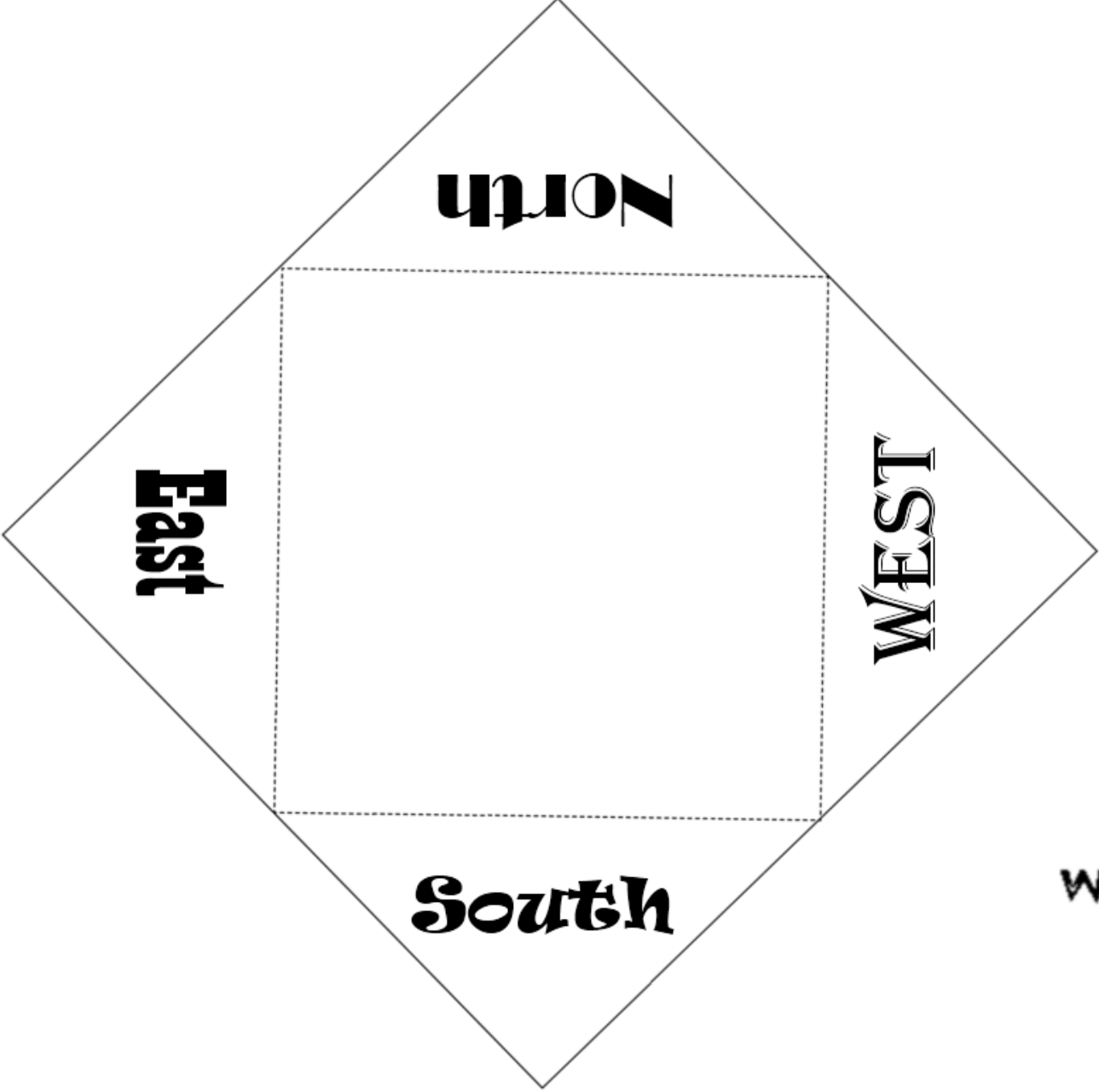
Use a standard office folder to create a portfolio, and glue all the pieces inside. There are photos at the end of this package with an example. I've refolded the folder to create a split cover. You can get as creative as you want to arrange all the bits and pieces.

The folded pieces open up and information is written in the blank spaces by the person making the book (either you or your child). Pieces and text can be colored in, and it makes a great project on altars when it's complete. A couple pieces are in color but they print fine on a black and white printer too.

So at the end, you've looked at what elements and directions can represent, what the main colors symbolize and created a list of what items might go on an altar. The Sabbat books are for some holiday items that you could use to represent the meanings of the Sabbats.

I guess it's pretty self-explanatory beyond this. Enjoy.
