

# The Celtic Pantheon



These pages contain all the pieces you need to make a lapbook on the Celtic Pantheon as well as some of the mythology.

Basically, all the components can be cut out along their borders, with the dotted lines indicated folds. Use a standard office folder to create a portfolio, and glue all the pieces inside.

There are photos at the end that should show how all the booklets look after folding. You can get as creative as you want to arrange all the bits and pieces. There should be room for everything, the photos are just a suggestion.

The folded pieces open up and information is written in the blank spaces by the person making the book (either you or your child). Graphics can be colored in if you want.

Overall, this project contains the main 10 Celtic Deities, the Druids, a map of Celtic lands to color, and a piece on the Triple Goddess. You'll have to do the research yourself for the information, this is just a set of pages to build the lapbook itself.

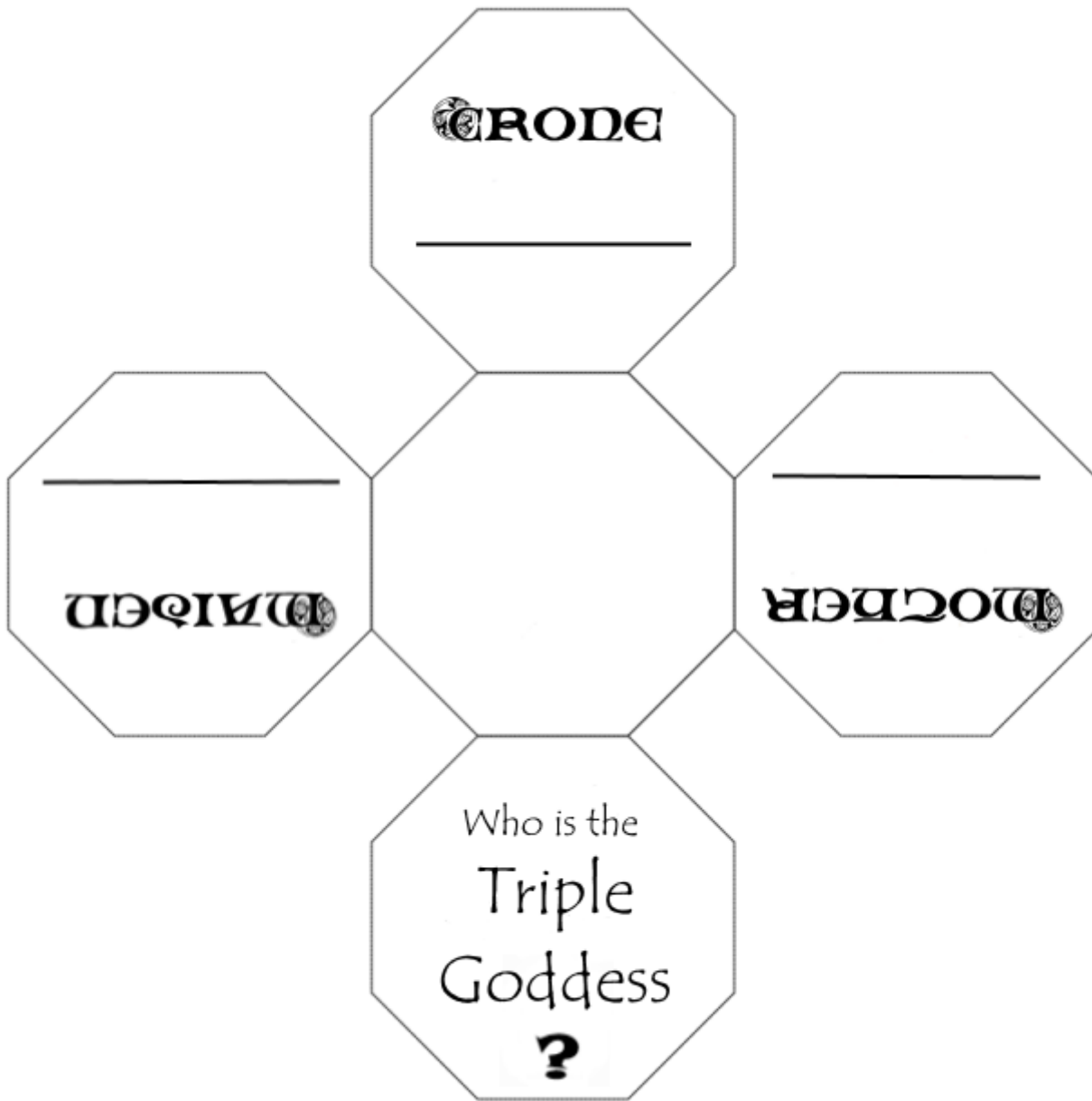
