

Reading a Pendulum

Reading a pendulum is an easy way to practice a little divination.

First, you need a pendulum. A "real" one is fine, but you can also use any small object that hangs freely from a chain or string. It should have a little weight to it, like a pendant, a key or even a small toy.

For this activity, we're going to use a printed board, which you'll find on the next page.

Hold the chain or string in your hand, and let the weight part (the bob) hang freely over the center of the diagram. Lean your elbow on a table or surface to keep your hand as steady as you can. Concentrate on your question and watch the bob move. If there is no movement, try again later.

You will get either a circular motion or a side-to-side. The board can give you an answer in either case. Clockwise is a yes, and counter-clockwise is a no for a spiral response.

Side-to-side motions can go in more directions, possibly giving more answers. Yes, no, maybe and the ? can mean either ask again later, or your question doesn't have an answer. Maybe think about it, and ask in a different way.

It's not perfect, and it can take some practice to really build up those psychic skills.
