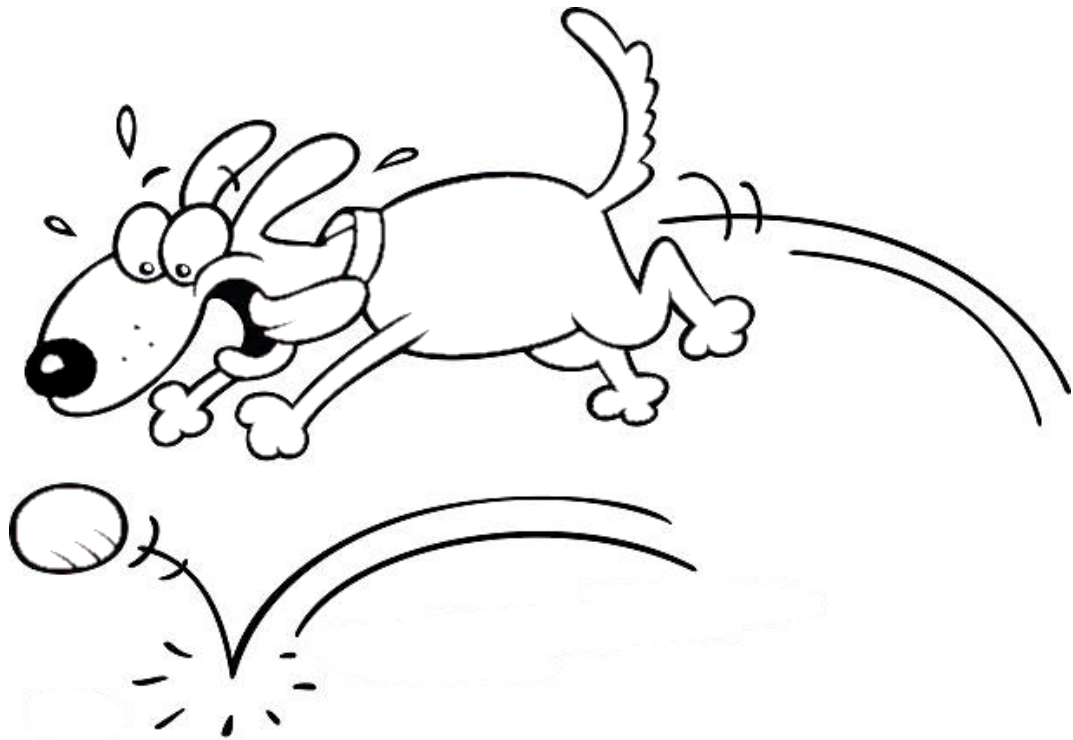
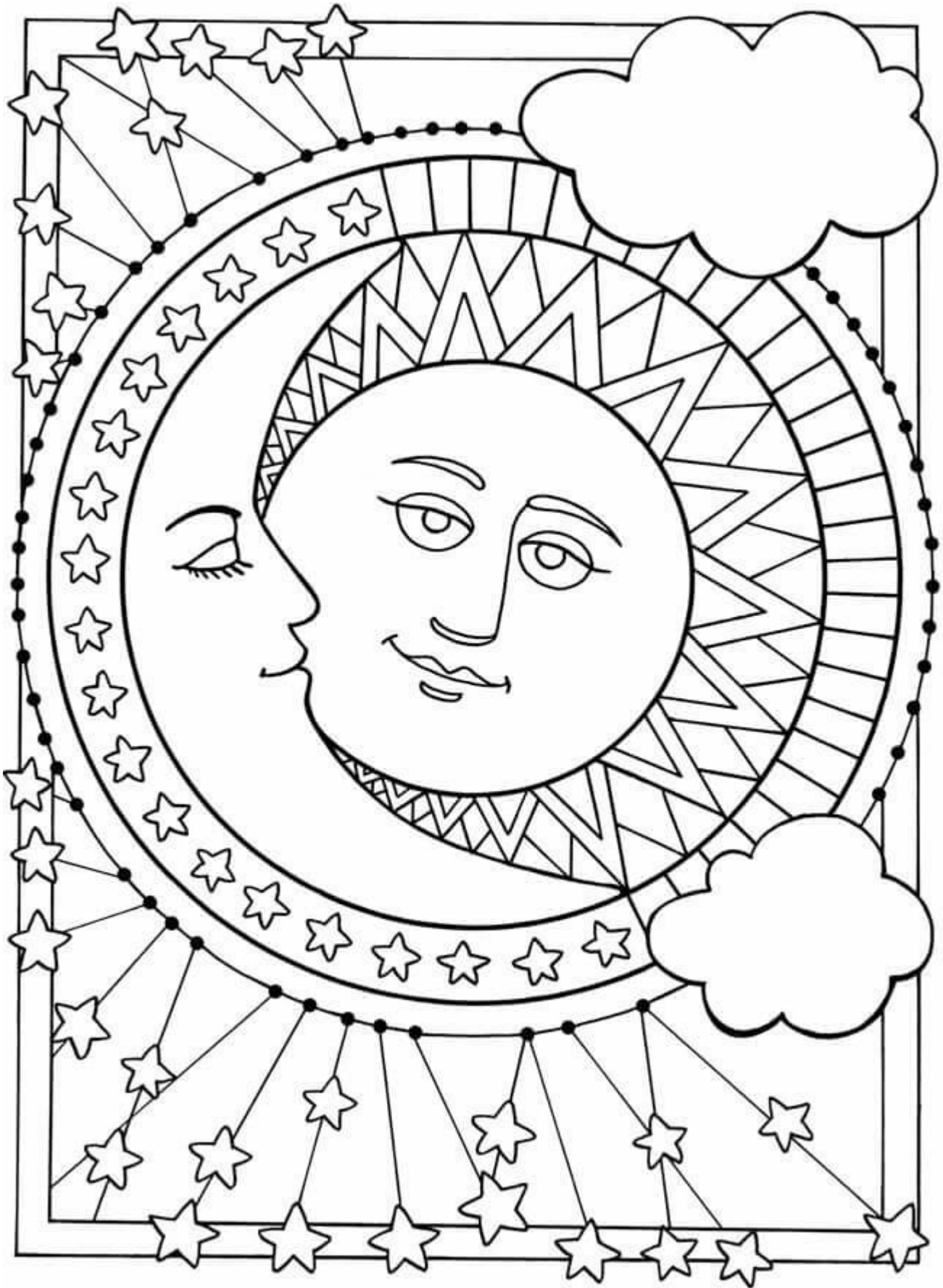


Skoll and Hati

Into the desolate forest,

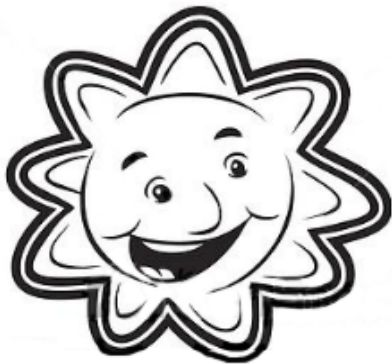
And the other is Hati,
