

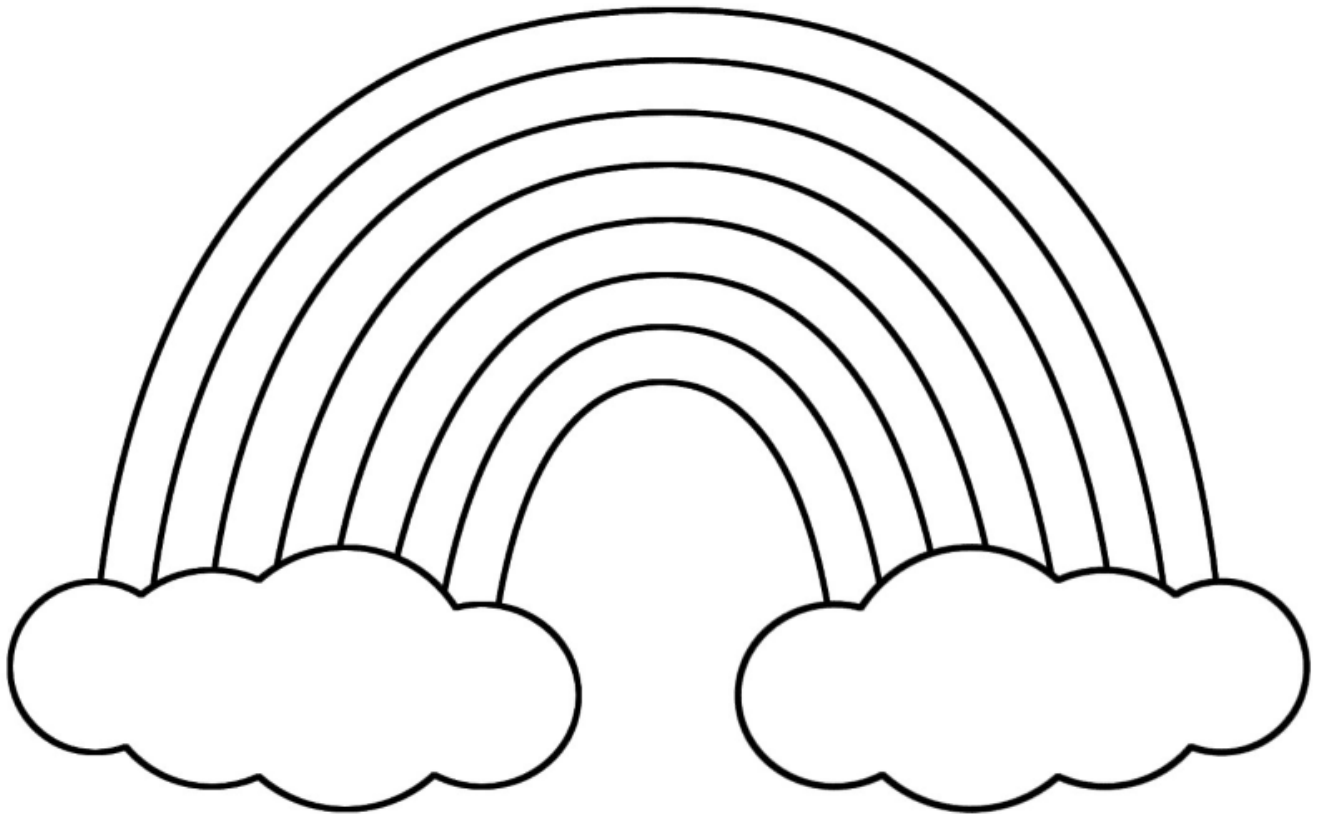
These pages contain all the pieces you need to make a lapbook on rainbows, aimed at fairly young kids.

Basically, all the components can be cut out along their borders, with the dotted lines indicated folds. Use a standard office folder to create a portfolio, and glue all the pieces inside.

There are photos at the end that should show how all the booklets look after folding. You can get as creative as you want to arrange all the bits and pieces. There should be room for everything.

The folded pieces open up and information is written in the blank spaces by the person making the book (either you or your child). There are *lots* of places for coloring.

Overall, this project contains 2 booklets with examples of colors, 1 showing the ROYGBIV rainbow color order, a little poem, a place to write your favorite color, some world mythology about rainbows, a rainbow maze and a piece that's just for coloring. Oh, and a big title.

REMOVE THIS AREA

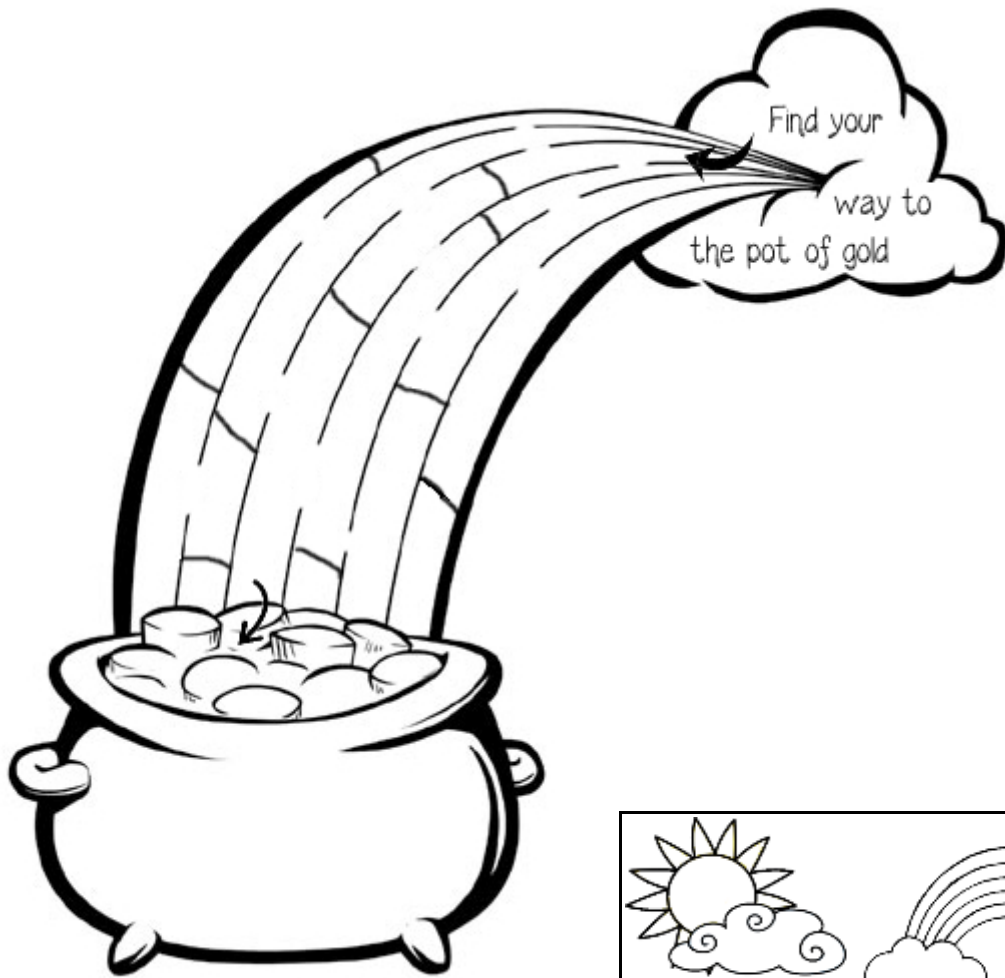
There is a pot of gold treasure
